Nutrition Project

We have been asked by the La Esperanza Hospital to help with this project that achieves four things. One teaches nutrition to expecting mothers as they come for prenatal care. Two, provides food to pregnant women.



Three, provides seed packs to take home and start their own garden. Four, encourages future expecting mothers to come and get prenatal care.



The youth we work with in Yamaranguila helped us clear land for planting a garden for the project. They will plant corn, beans, squash, tomatoes, peppers, etc.

Invasion Project

The Invasion is a camp of people who lost their homes, jobs, or are looking for a better life. They started coming to a field on the edge of La Esperanza three years ago.



We received a list of 45 single mothers with children under 5 years old that do not have food. Mercy International is conducting services most Saturday nights and has built a few homes. We would like to provide food and start a community garden.

Wow, three months in Honduras and look at the opportunities to show Gods love:

- **La Esperanza Hospital:**

- Re-equipping the hospital with updated equipment and supplies.
- The hospital has written a request to repair their leaking roof.
 - \$4,000 per section
 - We are looking for teams to come and work on the roof.

- **Nutrition Project:** We were asked by the Hospital Administration for help with this program

- providing food and nutrition classes to expecting mothers
- promote prenatal care
- providing seeds for mothers to start their own gardens

- **Invasion Project:**

- A camp of people who lost their homes, jobs, or are looking for a better life.
- 45 single mothers with children under 5 years old.
- Cost \$5 per week for three meals a week per child.

Thank you to all of you for your support and prayers. We are believing God to meet the following needs.

- **One Time Expenses**

- \$30,000 Build Staff Housing
 - A house for Mercy International that will be available to us while we are in Honduras
- \$30,000 4-wheel drive vehicles
- \$1,800 Honduras Resident Fees

- **Monthly Expenses**

- \$ 500 Housing
- \$ 500 Vehicle/Travel
- \$ 700 Food and Miscellaneous
- \$1,000 Ministry

- \$ 2,500 1 Year of correspondence from ABECCA
